About Faith Adventure Camp:

Faith Adventure Camp is in its 26th year, serving the Southwest Border District of the Evangelical Free Church. It is held at beautiful Mountain Meadows Ranch, on Christopher Creek.



This camp is certified by the American Camp Association and is open to all campers who have completed grades 2-6, regardless of race, religion, or physical handicap.

F.A.C. is known for its small group and hands-on activity program. Campers select four activities to participate in during their week at camp. The activity categories include: outdoor living skills, sports, crafts, communication arts, nature crafts and skills, and includes a wide variety of choices to fit campers' interests. Activity groups are limited to no more than 12 campers and include an adult leader and an assistant. This ensures that each camper receives personal attention.

Cabin groups at F.A.C. are kept small as well, consisting of no more than 10 campers. Campers are grouped by grade or age. Each cabin is led by a mature, trained Christian counselor as well as a trained junior counselor.

Since the goal of F.A.C. is to teach boys and girls about the Lord Jesus Christ, the highlight of camp is our time spent in worship, prayer, and studying God's Word. Campers are encouraged to develop and grow in their relationship with Jesus Christ. Give your kids an adventure they will always remember as they mature and grow in Christ through this excellent Christian camping experience!



The staff of F.A.C. strives to provide a camp experience which includes new friendships; close interpersonal relationships; and true adventure in, and appreciation of, God's creation. The facilities are rustic, yet safe and comfortable, and provide campers with a true out-of-city experience. The nutritious meals served have been "kid-tested and approved".



Parents provide transportation to and from camp. That way they can see where their child(ren) will spend the week and can meet their counselor. Camp check-in is from 2:00-4:00 pm, and the first camp session begins at 4:00 p.m. on Sunday. Children need to be picked up by 10:00 am on Saturday.

After sending your \$25 registration fee and form, you will receive a packet containing medical forms and information sheets to fill out and return. (Or you can download the forms on our website at www.fcov.org.) These will include directions to the camp, what to pack and other helpful information. Please fill out and return forms to Faith Church before camp in order to minimize your wait time at check-in on the first day of camp.

Sixth Grade Special!!

If you have finished 6th grade, we have planned a special program just for you! If you like camp just like you know it to be and want to do that, choose "regular camp." If you tend to be a little daring and adventuresome you may want to choose "6th Grade Special." You will be in regular camp program in the morning and "6th Grade Special"

will begin at lunch. You will have a 2 hour extended activity in the afternoon with your cabin group. Your "Specials" will include Outdoor Living Skills and Nature Activities. If you are interested in being in the "6th Grade Special" this year, check the box on your registration. There is no extra cost for the "6th Grade Special" program.
